THEME FOR 2026

"BELIEVE! It's Possible." — Mark 9:23 GOALS FOR 2026

1. A Year of Faith Development

Strategy:

• Host Faith, Finance, Family, and Healing Conferences throughout the year.

2. Increase Evangelism and Outreach

Strategy:

- Provide Evangelism training for the entire church in the Spring and Fall.
- Re-establish the Evangelism Team.
- Ask every member to create a prayer list of three people they desire to see saved in 2026.
- Hold monthly Soul Winning Weekends.
- Host Big Days in February, April, May, September, and December.
- Increase internal and external marketing.
- Conduct additional evangelistic events.
- Reach people through consistent Community Outreach.
- Practice Lifestyle Evangelism—reaching people where they are.

GOALS FOR 2026

2. Increase Evangelism and Outreach - Cont.

Strategy:

- Increase church attendance at all Mt. Olive campuses.
- Establish College Bible Studies.
- Increase visitor flow to 40 guests per week.
- Touch 200,000 people in 2026 through social media, television, radio, and personal invites.
- Encourage every member to bring two guests each month.
- Distribute flyers monthly for members to share.

3. Leadership Development

Strategy:

- We will strengthen current leaders and train new leaders to step forward and make a difference.
- Continue consistent Equip meetings on the first Saturday of each month.
- Provide seminars, workshops, and teachings focused on leadership.

4. Strengthening Ministries Within the Church

THE PROCLAIMED FAST

During these 21 days of Faith Development, our entire church will unite in a corporate fast.

We are abstaining from certain foods for *spiritual* breakthrough, believing God for:

- Personal growth
- Ministry advancement
- The fulfillment of our 2026 church goals

Fast Dates:

- Begins: Monday, January 5, 2026 at 12:00 AM
- Ends: Sunday, January 25, 2026 at 5:00 PM

All leaders, staff, adults, teens, and children are encouraged to participate. *Parents should use wisdom for children under age 12.*

If you have a medical condition or a job requiring manual labor, please exercise wisdom. Even if you must eat, you are still expected to honor the consecration through prayer, discipline, and devotion.

FASTING OPTIONS

Choose one of the following partial fasts:

1. The Daniel Fast

Eat any amount of approved foods. Pay close attention to labels—no added sugars or chemicals.

Allowed:

- All fruits and berries
- All vegetables and beans
- All nuts, seeds, and nut butters
- All whole grains
- Oils from vegetables, nuts, and seeds
- Tofu, soy products, vinegar, herbs, spices, and water

Not Allowed:

- All meat and animal products
- All dairy products
- All sweeteners (sugar, honey, syrup, etc.)
- Caffeine (coffee, tea, chocolate)
- Bread and fried foods

Choose one of the following partial fasts:

2. Dawn-to-Dusk Fast

No meals between 6:00 AM and 5:00 PM daily (including weekends).

Allowed:

- Water
- 100% juices

Not Allowed:

- Caffeine
- Carbonated drinks of any kind
- Sweetened beverages
- Sweets or desserts

3. One Meal a Day Fast

Eat one meal at the time of your choice.

Allowed:

- Water
- 100% juice

Not Allowed:

- Caffeine
- Carbonated drinks
- Sweetened drinks
- Sweets

• Limit secular television during the 21 days.
