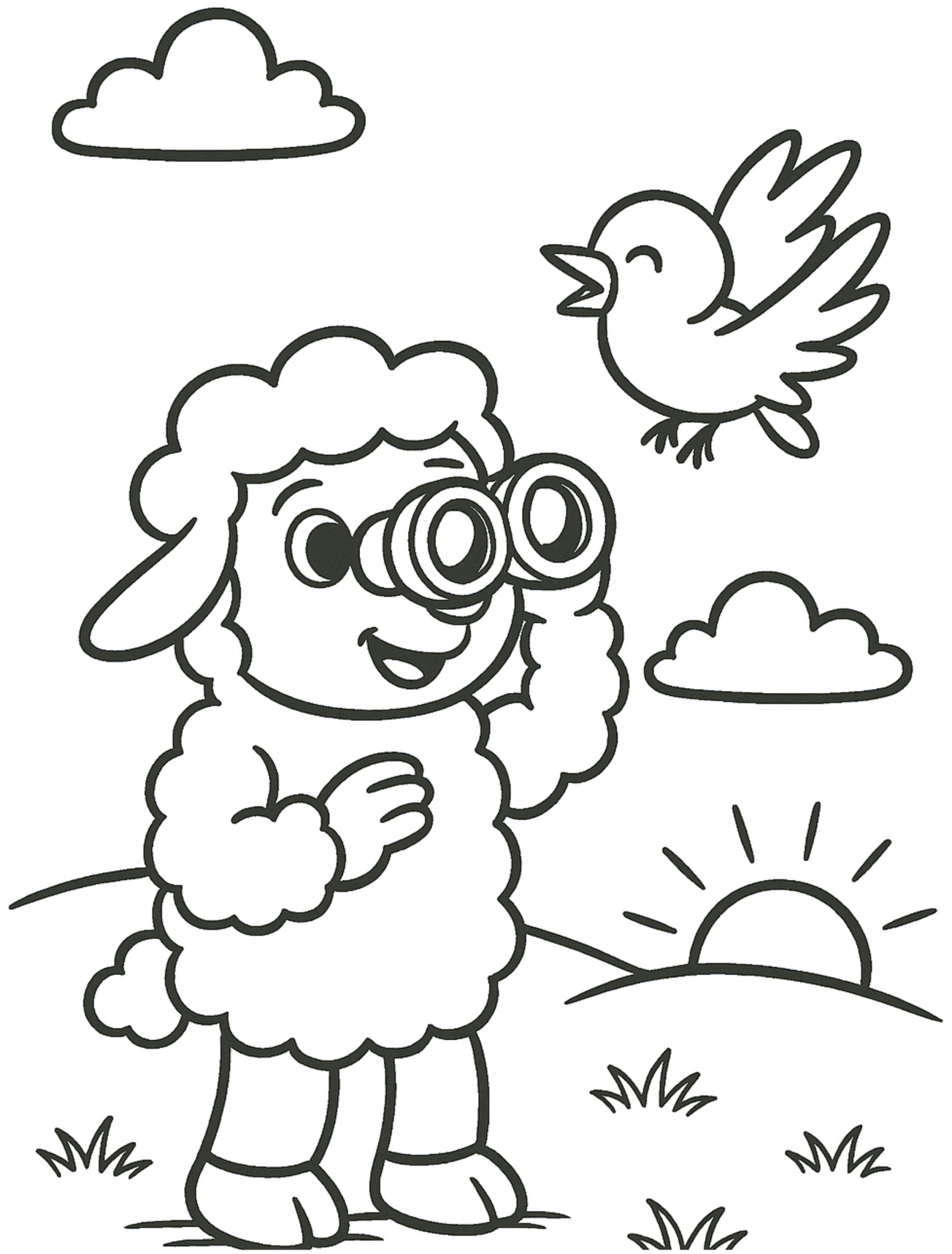


Mt. Olive Faithy Adventures

Before going to sleep, Faithy whispered a prayer.

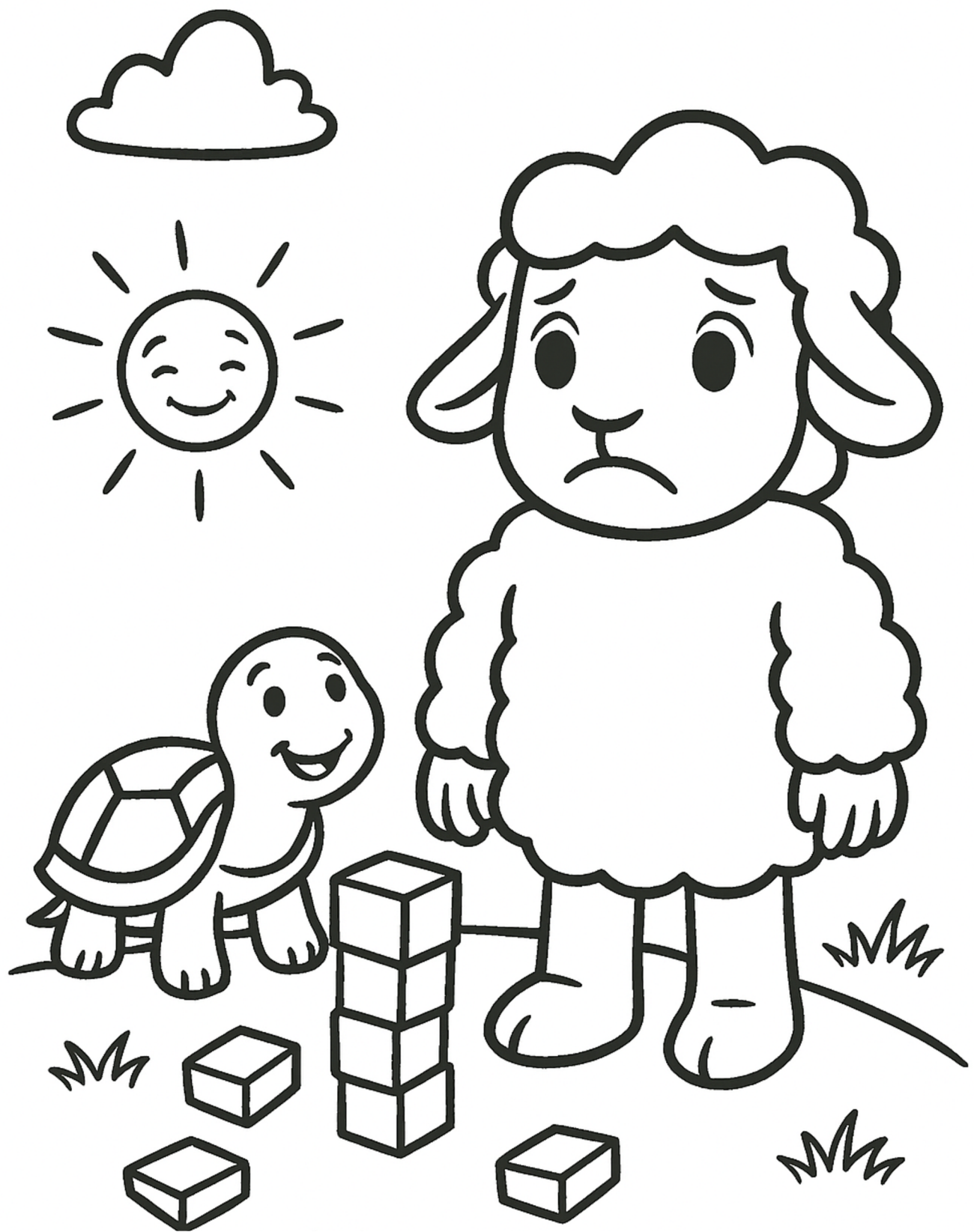
“God, thank You for today.” Hope the Bird said,
